5. NAGAAA Summer Meeting

a. Summary and wrap up report

New Partners for the NAGAAA organization- reach out to them and look for additional sponsorship National Gay and Lesbian Chamber of Commerce

Major League Baseball- IE 66ers, Lake Elsnore Pirates, Rancho Cucamongo (Local Teams)

New Member Cities-Salt Lake City

235 teams- record number- growing at a high rate. More money and fiscal concerns. Possibly adding a player fee for the GSWS. Possibly increasing the team fees for GSWS.

Host hotel revenue to the GSWS- percent at the host hotels are going down, so they need to recoup some of those costs

They are looking for consistently across all tournaments with only 2 nonrated players being eligible. They will allow new player additions to the open database.

Committee involvement available at the NAGAAA level.

A division declining in participation, B Division declining in participation, C division is steady, D division is growing, E division is growing, and Master's division is growing greatly.

Any tournament using a NAGAAA rating system must have in place a protest system.

A/B teams can pick up two players from another organization out of the 4 allowed pick up players.

Sin City Classic will use the new rating system. Changes to the ratings are outlined below.

Summary of NAGAAA-passed Changes to Player Ratings Questions 3-5, 11-14

- 1. Change to Ratings Questions 3-5, which will:
 - Remove current question 5 (Able to place hit the ball), move current question 4 (hit a fly ball over 300 feet) to be the new question 5, and change the threshold to 5% instead of 20%.
 - Split old question 3 (Hit a fair ball with high velocity) into two questions one with a threshold of 20% (new question 3) and one with a threshold of 60% (new question 4).
 - Players with new question 3 would not be allowed to play in the E Division and players with new question 5 would not be allowed to play in the D and E Divisions.
- 2. Change to Ratings Questions 11-14, which will:
 - Q10 didn't change
 - Change definition of Q11, replacing "3.75 seconds" to "4 seconds"
 - Change definition of Q12, replacing "3 seconds" to "3.5 seconds"
 - Change definition of Q13 to "From a stopped standing ready position, runs from home plate to first base, one base to the next, or third base to home plate (70 ft.) in less than 3 seconds"

• For Q14, remove the words "Division &" from the definition and add to the end of the definition, "measured as follows: 1) Batter reaches first, runner goes from first to third or runner goes from second to home; 2) Batter reaches second, runner goes from first to home"

- e. Competition Fall Rules (See PSGSL Rules for Details)
 - i. Games shall utilize the five (5) run per inning rule, with unlimited runs allowed after the completion of the fourth inning.
 - ii. Teams may bat their entire roster. All extra hitters must be included in the official line-up and may bat in any spot in the order.
 - iii. Pickups within your division or lower are allowed and not required to play RF or C, in the upper division you can only pickup an 'A' division player to replace another absent 'A' division player.
 - iv. Teams are allowed two (2) courtesy runners per inning
 - v. A pitching screen will be utilized in Upper Division

i. Upper Div: Each Opponent 3xii. D Div: Each Opponent 2X + 3iii. E Div: Each Opponent 6x
