Numbers: 188 RSVP's – roughly 92% of the league Combined with honored guests (HoF, sponsors, etc.) – we're at roughly 200 attendees In 2019, we had 15 teams and over 250 members – one of our largest seasons ever. Then we had 130 attend the Awards Banquet.

(Incidentally, we payed \$18.50 per person at the Cimarron that year. There price increased to \$27/person, which the Margaritaville undercut (and they're in town, is why we selected this year's venue.)

Friday we must provide a final headcount, which contractually binds us to \$26/person, whether they show or not. That totals \$5,200 for 200 attendees.

188 RSVP's (92%) is misleading. We have some teams with less than 10 people coming. A player plus one adult guest has always been the norm for the banquet. While we're not going to limit the number of adult guests a player can bring, we are requiring each team provide by 12PM this Friday the name of each player attending and the number of adult guests they are bringing.

As such, guests will check-in when they arrive and similar to a reservation at a restaurant or hotel, there will be a no-show fee for those that have RSVP'd and don't attend. Teams will be responsible for this fee to be eligible for next season.

This is not an ideal situation but we feel it is a fair action for all members of the league. \$5,200 line item in the budget affects everyone in the league.
