- 1) An Observation may only be filed by the following individuals;
 - A) A manager, coach, or scorekeeper of a registered Team of the PSGSL.
 - B) A member of the PSGSL Executive Board.
 - C) A member of the PSGSL given proxy by the Open Division Director.
- 2) An observation/player inquiry card must be filed **prior to the completion of all games on the day of competition**.
- 3) All information must be filled in correctly on the Observation Card.
- 4) Notify a member of the board that you wish to submit a player observation/inquiry card. You will be directed to turn in the observation card once completed to the board member on duty who will collect all cards each week.
- 5) The league Official (board member on duty) will accept or reject your observation based on your following of the required procedure. The Official validating the observation will provide a denial reason and will tell you exactly what the issue is preventing the observation from being validated. At that point, the observing party will need to immediately make required corrections or the observation card may be denied.
- 6) If the observation is validated, your observation will be forwards to the members of the ratings and review committee who will discuss the merits of your observation as well as determine if the player in question should be placed on a watch list. You may continue to submit further observation cards for the same player for each time they demonstrate a skill in question.
- 7) Based on collected observation cards, committee watch lists/observations, a recommendation will be made to the board regarding the player's rating and need to adjust skills in question.
